Eventually, Meaghan Farrell moved to Nashville, Tennessee, where she would begin a journey of self-discovery and healing. Meaghan now boasts two additional full-length albums (*Conversations with Myself* and *Motherland*), both of which were produced by Dan and Nate Monea from Hey Monea! In addition to these accomplishments, Meaghan has gone on numerous tours with other artists, such as Red Wanting Blue, Will Hoge, and Leah Marlene, and has performed on the famous music cruise The Rock Boat for three consecutive years.
